Introductions

Introductions were made in person prior to beginning of meeting. Zoom meeting started and everyone have a brief introduction

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss egress for potential traffic changes along Patterson Rd., between 25 and 25.5 Rd. The City would like to add a median down Patterson that would eliminate traffic from leaving the HOA and taking a left onto Patterson, as well as eliminate east-bound traffic from entering the HOA from the south on Patterson, moving north into the HOA.

In short, the City plans to eliminate exit 40 on their Access Control Plan to block with a median, all eastbound traffic from using the 40 Foresight Cir. Entrance. The City would also block all traffic from exiting the HOA at exit 39 from crossing Patterson to join westbound traffic.

Renee, owner of the former Athletic Club, brought a civil traffic engineer that asked numerous pertinent and cogent questions as to the approval process and when these changes might take place.

Ron Sechrist noted that these changes would further congest the 25 and 25.5 Rd. intersections and would further force vehicle traffic into the HOA, where many roads are already very narrow, which will make traffic inside the HOA more unsafe. Ron requested the City review this as the entrances and exits in use alleviate those intersections and make movement safer. The proposed City changes will almost certainly make traffic less safe along Patterson and inside the HOA.
