Old or New Business

Rebekah W opened the floor for discussion on old or new business

- **Amendment to Bylaws:** Discussion regarding amending bylaws to stagger board member terms. Due to not meeting the 40% quorum, a vote could not be held.

- **Mailbox Numbers:** Discussion about adding mailbox numbers for new homeowners. The HOA will look into options for residents to add the numbers.
- **Pond Maintenance:** The pond failed inspection. Ben Dowd (original contractor) will be hired to redo the pond. The cost is \$2,875. A resident inquired about the contribution of the other HOA that is next to Apple Glen to the cost of the pond maintenance. It was stated that the other HOA will not be contributing to the cost, as the pond is all rock.
- **Overwatering/Irrigation:** Residents discussed overwatering issues and potential impact on the detention pond. Residents are encouraged to be mindful of water usage.
- Pet Waste and Noise
 - A resident raised concerns about possible violations of pet restrictions (number of dogs, waste, noise).
 - It was recommended that the resident first talk to the neighbor.
 - Rebekah W will send out a general reminder email regarding pet waste and being considerate of neighbors.
 - It was clarified that noise complaints should be directed to Animal Control or the City of Grand Junction.

Budget

Rebekah W opened discussion for the Budget.

- Julie presented the proposed budget for the upcoming year, explaining the need for increased dues to cover rising costs.
- The proposed increase is approximately from 499/500 to 540/545.
- An amount of \$9000 in landscaping was insured into the budget.
 - An explanation for the increase in landscaping costs was provided. The increase is due to the amount of weeds that need replaced, as well as bushes that have died.
- There were some discussions regarding a potential warranty on the pump.
- It was discussed to put manure to fertilize the landscaping.
- It was stated that if the pump needs to be completely replaced, that it would cost \$60,000.
- The reserve balance was inquired about.
 - Board to review and discuss starting a separate reserve account
- It was noted that the revenue comes in Q1.
