Dryland Grass Mix:

(From Seed - drilled or raked into ground)

For meadow - Dryland Blend (Blue Grama, Sideoats Grama, Indian Ricegrass, Western Wheatgrass, Galleta Grass, Shorty Fescue) or a mix such as the "Western Trails" Mix from High Country Gardens.

Wildflowers for the sunny Dryland Grass Areas:

(From seed - High Country Juniper Mix or from separate packets in feature areas)

Aster biglovii, Lewis Blue Flax, California Poppy, Evening Primrose, Fendler's Sundrops, Gallardia, Orange Globe Mallow, Mexican Hat, Prairie Coneflower, Helianthus, Penstemon (red - barbatus, eatonii, pinifolius, & blue - strictus, watsonii), Perky Sue, Prince's Plume, Sand Verbena, Scarlet Gilia, Prairie Zinnia

Also add seeds for desert shrubs such as: Rabbitbrush, Sand Sage, Fringed Sage, 4-wing Saltbush, Shadscale, Mormon Tea, Yucca harrimenea

Lawn:

Grasses from the Dryland Grass Mix can be used as a lawn if it is watered and mowed. The best grasses are the "Hachita" Blue Gramma and the Shorty Fescue. There is a grass mix named "Low Work and Water" Mix offered in the High Country Gardens Catalogue that might work also.

Easy Perennials for Planting in the yards and for Focal Points in the Common Landscape:

Groundcovers & flowers -

Ajuga, Creeping phlox

Early summer:

Tall - Daylily,

Echinacea, Yarrow (yellows, whites, orangy)

Medium - Coreopsis, Penstemon -

Shasta Daisy, Red Hot Poker

Low - Pineleaf Penstemon, Sedum

Salvia "May Night", Hardy Ice Plant

Summer:

Tall - Hummingbird Mint, Desert 4 O'Clock

Jupiter's Beard

Medium - Gallardia, Liatris

Black-eyed Susan

Low - Homestead Purple or Red Devil Verbena, Winecups, "Shimmer" Evening Primrose

Fall:

Tall - Russian Sage, Solidago

Gaura, Salvia greggi "Cold Hardy Pink"

Medium - Purple Dome Aster, Chrysanthemums

Autumn Joy Sedum

Low - Ornamental Oregano,

Hardy Plumbago, Campanula "Bluebells"

Artemesia "Seafoam"
